Remember this is a "TAX CREDIT" which you subtract directly from your Arizona state taxes and not adjusted from your gross income.

NOTE: In addition since NSAA Middle and High School is a non-profit education facility, you may also claim the money as a charitable donation on your Federal Income tax.
